

Reading Box Chart

Cut cards out individually. Put in a bag. Pull one out at a time, choose a favorite storybook, and read it with your child the way the card suggests. Do this as many times as you'd like; you can choose to do each card suggestion with the same book, or switch books out as you choose new "reading box cards" to make it more engaging and diverse for you and your child.

Read a story outside together under a shady tree	Read a story on the bed, Your bed or your child's bed...your choice!	Do a picture-walk! Read a story only looking at the pictures and talking about them	Read the story from end to beginning
Make a "tent" with blankets. Read the story "in" the tent!	Read the story sitting on the floor with pillows	Read the story during bath time	Read the story at a park
Read the story normal first. Re-read the story fast. Then, re-read the story slow.	Whisper the whole time when reading the story.	Read 2 stories anywhere in the house	Read the story. Go back and count the pages in the book.
Read the story. Go back and count all of the words in the story.	YOUR CHOICE! Read wherever, however you would like!	Read the story on the couch	Read the story. Go back and tell your child who, what, and where?
