

Objective: The child recognizes the alphabet while reading a story and can read along.

Materials needed:

ABC eStory (eBook &/or Printable)

Procedures:

- 1. In a quite, comfy area sit with your child. You can choose to pull the eBook up on your computer or Kindle and read with child directly from the screen and/or Print it out.
- 2. Flip through the story book with your child. Look at the pictures only. Have them tell you what they are while pointing to each.
- 3. Now read it together! Have them say, or repeat after you read, each letter on each page.
- 4. Ways to help child learn to read: Look at pictures. Say letters. Re-read sentences after you read them first. Look for known, short words they already recognize. Point to words while reading. Consistency in reading.



Milestones to meet:

The child can recognize letters. The child can listen to a story about the alphabet and says the letters when reading. The child shows early reading readiness by helping read a story, and naming pictures in a story they know. The child knows at least half of the alphabet letters and can recognize them.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
