



ABC Tracing

Ages 4 years to 5 years

Objective: The child can use early writing skills to trace the letters in the alphabet.

Materials needed:

ABC Tracing sheet (printable)

Pencil or Crayon (for them to write with)

Procedures:

1. Have your child trace each of the letters in the alphabet on the printable sheet.
2. Do with them for guidance and understanding. Show how to trace using a high lighter or marker. Have child do.
3. While tracing each letter one at a time, have your child tell you the name of that letter and what sound it makes. To build higher-order learning, have child tell you a word they know that begins with that letter. Help them think as necessary.



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Milestones to meet:

The child can use fine-motor skills to trace letters. The child can recognize and say alphabet letters. The child can tell you the sound each letter in the alphabet makes. The child begins to understand how to think of words that begin with specific alphabet letters.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
