



Painting My Name

Ages 4 years—5 years

Objective: The child can recognize the letters in their name while exploring with paint dots.

Materials needed:

White sheet of paper

Something to write with

Paint brush

Paint

Procedures:

1. Write out your child's name on the white sheet of paper. Have your child say each letter while you write. If they have mastered writing, let child write out their own name on the paper.
2. Hand them a paint brush. Model and show child what to do using your finger to trace over the letters in their name. Do one letter at a time! Say each letter as you do so.
3. Explain to child to use paint and the paint brush to trace over each letter in their name.
4. Have child say each letter as they do so.
5. View example picture on next page.



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Milestones to meet:

The child knows the letters in their name. The child can say and recognize the letters in their name. The child builds early writing skills. The child can trace over letters using paint and a paint brush.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
