

Objective: The child will learn their colors after seeing & repeating them.

Materials needed:

Christmas Lights Colors (printable)

Optional: Paint & Q-tips (variety of colors of paint)

Procedures

- 1. Sit your child at a small table for this activity.
- 2. You are going to show the printable sheet to your child, point to each color one at a time while saying the colors name out loud. Ask child to repeat that colors name after you. (I.e. "Can you say blue? Point to the color blue with me.")
- 3. Then point to the color word and say the name of the color again. Point to each letter spelling out the color word. Ask child to repeat the color.
- 4. Do this same thing repeating teaching steps in #2 and 3 until all colors have been taught.
- 5. For extra fun with colors—let your child paint the same colors on top of the lights (printable sheet) using the Q-tips.



Milestones to meet:

The child begins recognizing their colors. The child can paint on top of the matching color using Q-tips. The child can repeat a colors name after hearing it.

Evaluation:

Did this lesson work for your child? Why or why not?
