• On 7 Popsicle sticks, write a different letter of the alphabet. There are 26 letters in the alphabet, so start with letter Aa and continue weekly until all letters have been written on a stick and been gone through. Remember to write both capitol and lowercase letter such as, Aa and Bb. Every morning after breakfast, let your child "pick a stick" and tell you what letter is on it. For preschoolers, ask them to point to the capitol letter, then point to the lowercase letter. Ask them to think of a word that begins with that letter of the alphabet. Have child make the sound that letters makes. Afterwards, have child put the stick back and re-draw a stick again the next morning, all week long!
